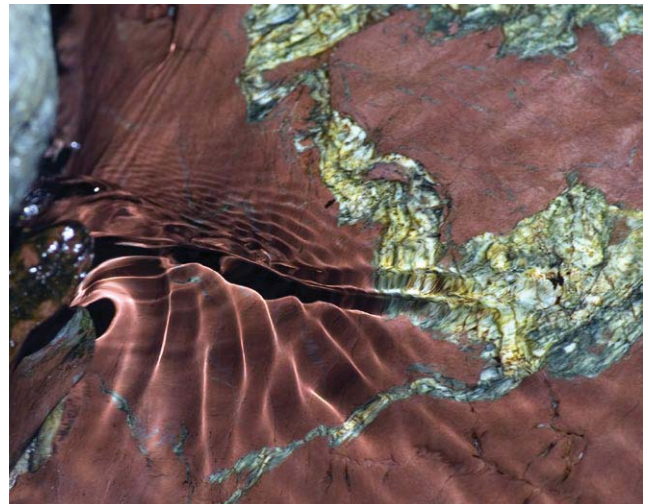




BLUE WELLINGTON digital photography competition for Seaweek

Photograph Specifications

Photos must be taken during Seaweed 2010 (7 to 14 March 2010)

Photos must be originally shot on a digital camera.

They are to be supplied as JPEG files, preferably around A4 size at 300dpi.

Entries may be e-mailed (maximum size for e-mail: 5MB) or sent in on a CD.

Conditions of Entry

1. Image entered must have been taken by the entrant.
2. Only one entry per person.
3. Prizes are not redeemable for cash.
4. Copyright ownership of the image remains with the photographer.
5. Entrant gives Blue Wellington and Forest and Bird continued and unrestricted use of image for future conservation promotions. The photographer will be acknowledged whenever a photo is used.
6. Winners will be notified by 7 April 2010 at Blue Wellington April meeting. Prizes will be delivered to them.
7. The judges' decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
8. Relatives of the judges or relatives of employees of the Forest and Bird are prohibited from entering the competition.
