WHO ARE WE?

Forest & Bird Youth is a nationwide network of young people (aged 14-25) who are protecting and restoring Aotearoa's wildlife and wild places. We're also up-skilling ourselves and building our leadership abilities. From tree plantings and beach cleanups, to public campaigns and lobbying decision-makers to act for Nature, there is something for everyone.


HOW DOES IT WORK?

Forest & Bird Youth is run by young people, for young people, with the support of Forest & Bird staff.

Our National Network is made up of Forest & Bird Youth Hubs located around Aotearoa (see the map) and virtual nationwide Hubs (e.g. our Campaigns Hub and Social Media Hub). We also have a National Leadership team.

Some Hubs meet up in person and contribute their time to running events or to local conservation projects. Others meet online to discuss environmental issues or run advocacy campaigns.

You can be involved in as many Hubs as you like and new Hubs can be formed around any interest area. You can choose how you want to participate - whether it's attending events, engaging online, running new events or projects, or getting involved in leadership roles.



We currently have hubs in Northland, Auckland, Hawkes Bay, Kāpiti, Wellington, Nelson, Christchurch, and Southern (Southland).
