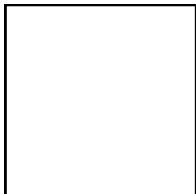
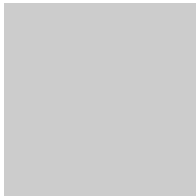
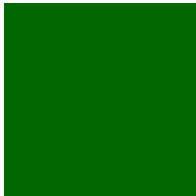


# The rainbow forest


