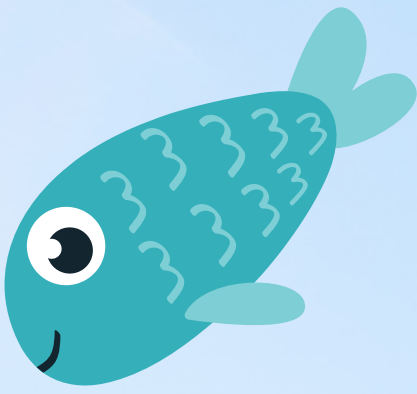

Getting to Waiheke Island

Catch the ferry to the Mataitia ferry terminal – check the Fullers website for timetable and fares.

If you're leaving from downtown Auckland, we recommend catching the 8am ferry to arrive in time for the pōwhiri.

On the island

You need to make your own way to the marae

Catch a public bus

The 502 bus from the Mataitia ferry terminal goes to stop 1161 on Tūi Street. The marae is a short, flat walk from the bus stop. You will need an AT Hop card to catch the bus (purchase at the ferry terminal).

Catch a taxi

Five minutes from the ferry terminal to the marae.

Walk

Thirty minutes from the ferry terminal to the marae.

Free return bus to ferry provided

Free return bus to the Mataitia ferry terminal departing Piritahi Marae at 4pm
