

### Getting to Waiheke Island

Catch the ferry to the Mataitia ferry terminal – check the Fullers website for timetable and fares. If you're leaving from downtown Auckland, we recommend catching the 8am ferry to arrive in time for the powhiri.

#### On the island

You need to make your own way to the marae Catch a public bus

The 502 bus from the Matiatia ferry terminal goes to stop 1161 on Tūī Street. The marae is a short, flat walk from the bus stop. You will need an AT Hop card to catch the bus (purchase at the ferry terminal).

#### Catch a taxi

Five minutes from the ferry terminal to the marae.

#### Walk

Thirty minutes from the ferry terminal to the marae.
