Please join us for a visit to Rangiwahia Scenic Reserve. Within the Reserve there are two pest-control tracks that are able to be walked by the public - the Reserve Track which is 2.1kms return, and the slightly more challenging Reserve-Lookout Track which is 4.5kms return.

Left untouched by early settlers - as a result, Rangiwahia has a 130-acre native virgin bush reserve which is a beautiful treasure, with many magnificent native tree specimens, including rimu, miro, matai, maire, kahikatea, a few totara, rewarewa, several species of rata, including northern rata, 5 varieties of tree ferns and extensive variety of ferns. Also, there are some stunning viewpoints along the way, and bird life is plentiful at certain times of the year.
